Site Rules and Information for Cooking Teams

April 5, 2024 VIP Dinner

**Each registered team will receive 2 tickets to the VIP Dinner held from 6-8pm.

Facilities:

- Johnson County Sheriff Posse, 1315 S. Main, Cleburne, TX
- Space for camper and smoker (no hook-ups/electricity).
- Limited water is available at the location.
- Live Animal(s) are not permitted. Only appropriately trained ADA dogs are permitted.
- There is no black (or gray) dump station at the Sheriff Posse.
 - Local Black Water Tank Dump Station:
 - Loves, Burleson \$10
- Overnights are permitted Friday and Saturday. All sites must be empty and clean by 10:00am on Sunday, April 7.
- Under no circumstances are there to be any stakes driven into the asphalt/concrete.
- No open fires on the grounds.

- All drippings from BBQ pit must be contained. Please be sure to bag and dispose of properly.

Safety:

- All flames and hot coals must be exterminated and disposed of properly.
- No pyrotechnics, or explosives are allowed.
- No weapons may be discharged or on display which could result in injury or inappropriate access by a non-authorized person.
- A team may be assessed charges or disqualified from further participation in the contest on any subsequent contest in the event that the team either causes damage to the grounds or leaves its space in disarray or with loose bundled trash or garbage following the contest.
- Cooks are to prepare and cook barbeque in as sanitary a manner as possible. Cooking conditions are subject to inspection.
- Security and safety are the sole responsibility of each team/contestant.
- ReInspire and its employees, volunteers, Board members or contractors are not responsible for any injury/injuries.

Family Friendly Event:

- Any nudity, lewdness, or any form of vulgarity will NOT be allowed.
- Alcohol at your site must be in individual serving cups during the public event (April 6).
- Manage your intake so behavior is appropriate for this family friendly event.
- EXCESSIVE use of alcoholic beverages will be grounds for disqualification. Contestants must not give, offer, sell or donate alcohol to the general public.
- No illegal substances or legal substances that result in inappropriate behavior at the event are permitted.
- No music or loud sounds which interfere with announcements and entertainment on stage, or which intrude upon or interfere with the

comfort of fellow contestants.

- Behavior that is a distraction or disruption to the event will not be tolerated. This determination is made by ReInspire or a Representative of ReInspire.
- Warnings may or may not be offered, but in the event of a warning, non-compliance will be grounds for disqualification and expulsion from the event space.
- In the event of suspected criminal behavior, law enforcement will be called.

In General:

- The Head Cook for each team will be responsible for the conduct of his team and invitees.
- The Head Cook is responsible for ensuring his/her team knows the rules and is in compliance with the rules and regulations.
- Teams will not offer Barbeque for SALE.
- Award Ceremony is scheduled for 4pm.
- This is an Outlaw BBQ Sanctioned events. The rules and regulations provided by Outlaw BBQ apply.
